# INTERNATIONAL STAGE – 33<sup>RD</sup> SIICUSP Guidelines for poster presentation and formatting



## **Poster Presentation**

- Authors must be present to interact with reviewers during the designated session.
- Reviewers may be either Brazilian or foreign, so questions may be asked in either Portuguese or English.
- All materials must be in English.

### **Poster Requirements**

LANGUAGE: English

MAXIMUM SIZE: 90 cm (width) x 120 cm (height)

## **Poster Organization and Layout Suggestions**

#### **FONT SIZES:**

• Title: 60 pt

Headings: 30 pt

Body text: 20 pt (ensure text is readable from 1.5 meters away)

**LAYOUT:** Use two or three columns. Ensure the content is well-organized and that colors highlight the main messages clearly.

**VISUALS:** Include graphs, diagrams, images, photos, and subtitles to present ideas concisely.

**MATERIAL:** Poster should be made of one-piece vinyl or paper, or multiple A4 sheets.

### STRUCTURE:

#### • Title of Research:

Must be exactly the same as the title registered in the SIICUSP submission.

Name and address of the institution where the research was conducted. Logos or names of sponsors/partners may also be included (max 5 cm x 5 cm).

#### Author Names:

List the researchers responsible for the work.

#### • Introduction:

A brief explanation of the problem or question studied, including the objective or hypothesis.

#### Materials and Methods:

Describe the procedures, equipment, materials, and strategies used in the development and analysis of the research.

#### • Development:

Outline the execution phases, analysis, and conclusions. Remember, the process is just as important as the final result. Show the scientific or technological steps involved.

#### Results:

Present the findings obtained using the methods described.

#### • Conclusions:

Summarize the key takeaways of your work.

#### • References:

Include a list of the references cited throughout the poster. Be sure to attribute any ideas, quotations, or external content to their original authors.

#### Note:

Any text or content not created by the authors must be properly attributed with the correct author and source.
